## **Annual General Members Meeting Update**

At the AGMM held on Feb. 7th Corey Henry, Pat Lewis, Cynthia Phillips and Brian Marshall Schieder were appointed to the Board; each will serve a two year term. They will be joining Moudu Ekhar, Nazreth Mebrahtu and Peter Norman on the Board of Directors.

Thank you to Jacques Monfiston for his service on the Board. Jacques completed his second consecutive term (four years straight) on the Board of Directors. Jacques was a valued contributing Board member and will be greatly missed.

Currently there are 102 artist members at LVAC. Of these 102 members 35 attended the AGMM on Feb. 7<sup>th</sup> and 14 sent their regrets prior to the meeting. Thank you to those that attended the AGMM and to those that had the courtesy to forward their regrets. Your participation in your co-op is greatly appreciated.

LVAC's Organizational By-Law 1A, Article 10 regarding participation states, "Each artist member is obligated to participate in the activities of the co-op by attending each annual meeting of members. If you are unable to attend the annual general members meeting, please forward your regrets to the co-of office".

There were 53 artist members (more than half) unaccounted for at the AGMM on Feb. 7th. They did not attend the members meeting or forwarded their regrets.

## **Monthly Fire Alarm Testing**

The monthly fire alarm testing is scheduled for Wed., March 28<sup>th</sup> between 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. The alarms will sound intermittently during the testing period however should there be a real fire, the alarms will sound continuously. Please be alert for actual fire emergencies during the day and respond appropriately.

## **Recycling**

It is extremely important to flatten boxes before putting them in the Blue bin to make room for more recycling. Please flatten your boxes before putting them in the blue bin.

**Please do not put your recycling in black garbage bags as this contaminates the entire Blue bin and increases costs for LVAC.** Only clear bags are acceptable.

The City of Toronto is starting a cost recovery payment from buildings that set out contaminated recycling bins. Buildings that are found to have contaminated Blue bins are notified that the Blue bin was rejected due to contamination and are charged for an additional garbage bin lift. To find out what is and isn't recyclable check out Toronto.ca waste wizard for the most up-to-date listings.

## **Laundry Room Etiquette**

Please be considerate of others by respecting the laundry room hours of operation, promptly removing your laundry from the machines when the cycle is done and cleaning up after yourself.

Cleaning staff cleans the laundry rooms thoroughly once per week. Laundry room users are responsible for cleaning up after themselves by emptying lint traps, cleaning the dispensers, wiping down the machines etc.

**Note: Leaving the washing machine doors open after each use helps dry out the door seal and prevents unpleasant smells and mold.**
